3. Welfare and Global Branch Outreach Program Update.

Welfare Report for May/June 2020

Since last meeting I have signposted one member to appropriate help and support.

The RAFA Outreach Programme has delivered over 300 food bags of vital supplies to our RAF family. However, I understand the Association prepared 1,000 food bags and has been surprised at the low level of demand and now determining what to do with the excess food bags. Initially thought that the excess food would be used at the Wings Break Hotels but as there is now a plan to close them end-July, that outlet is no longer available. Food bag hubs have already been asked to dispose of the milk as that goes out of date in July 2020.

The Telephone Befriending service is understood to have contacted 30.000 members of the RAF family during Lockdown. Many have appreciated the calls but others have expressed concern at being cold called by the Association. The Global Branch has only contacted members who consented to being contacted.

The Entertainment Channel has had a good following with some items achieving over 60,000 views.
