Annual RAFA Conference 2023

RAFA Annual Conference 2023 will be held at the Hilton Birmingham Metropole, The NEC Birmingham, Pendigo Way, Birmingham, B40 1PP

14 to 15 October 2023

Any individual wishing to attend Conference, in any capacity, MUST register using the process set out in section 8 below.

Please see section 9 below about the costs of attending Conference.

Registering your place for Conference

To register your attendance, please complete the online booking form on our website here: www.rafa.org.uk/conferences by 29 September 2023. Here you can register yourself and any guests who wish to attend the Conference. A registration form is required for each guest. Please note, this year accommodation will be booked directly through the RAF Association. This will be done via the registration form.

When registering, you will be asked to confirm whether you are attending in an official capacity (e.g., as a Branch delegate, Standard Bearer) or privately as a member or a guest. On successful registration you will receive a confirmation email from the Association. On your arrival, we will book you in and give you an identification badge and lanyard.

Please note that you do not require a ticket for the event. Your badge and lanyard will provide you access to the venue and evening functions and refreshments. If you do not have access to the internet, please contact our Customer Engagement Team on 0800 018 2361 (Mon-Fri, 0900-1700) and they will be happy to take your details over the phone.

9 Booking your accommodation

All accommodation bookings must be made directly with the RAF Association. The Hilton Birmingham Metropole has over 790 rooms with 20 accessible rooms. The Association has negotiated a reduced rate for a 24-hour residential rate for delegates at £235 per person (if sharing a room, the second person would pay an additional £125). If you are sharing a room, payment should be made for all occupants by the lead guest. The price includes your meals (Saturday lunch, dinner, and Sunday breakfast), accommodation (Saturday night) and car parking and connection to the venues Wi-Fi.

In addition, refreshments will be available over the weekend and each bedroom offers an en-suite bathroom, TV, hairdryer, tea/coffee, and biscuits. Anyone who does not require accommodation, the day rate is £100. This includes lunch, dinner and parking. Anyone who will not be attending the gala dinner will be charged a day rate of £55 which includes parking. Accommodation can be booked when registering at www.rafa.org.uk/conferences.

Additional Nights: If you require additional nights, these are to be arranged directly with the Hilton Birmingham Metropole. To book additional nights at Hilton Birmingham Metropole, please telephone 0121 780 6262. Please inform us if you are booking additional nights.

Annual RAFA Conference 2023 (cont'd)

Car parking: Hilton Birmingham Metropole has over 600 car parking spaces available on site and we have negotiated free parking for all those attending the Conference; however, you will need to provide us with your registration when you register for Conference.

Blue Badge Parking: There is a secure VIP and Blue Badge car park directly outside the venue. To gain access you will need to confirm that you are a Blue Badge holder and provide us with your relevant car registration in advance (when you register for Conference). Please note, the Association does not have exclusive use of this car park, places will be on first come first serve basis.

Mobility aids: Please note that Hilton Birmingham Metropole is unable to provide mobility aids such as wheelchairs or scooters. If you require any mobility aids, then please bring these with you.

Transport from Birmingham Airport and International Train Station: The venue is well-connected with Birmingham Airport and Birmingham International Station only 5/10 minutes away by taxi.

Any member of the Association is welcome to attend the Annual Conference at their own expense.

Accommodation: your accommodation will be available from 1500hrs on the day of your arrival, please note rooms will not be available earlier.

Marketplace, Saturday 14 October: The marketplace will be situated within the Balmoral room and will open from 1100hrs to 1800hrs. The stalls will give members and guests information on how we can support branches and help the RAF family. There will also be the chance to buy products from our Association shop.

Lunch & Refreshments, Saturday 14 October: will be available from 1200hrs in the Balmoral room. This will give delegates, members, and guests the opportunity to meet before being seated at 1245hrs for the opening ceremony at 1300hrs in the Sandringham room.

Annual Reunion Gala Awards Dinner, Saturday 14 October: This will take place in the Kings Suite from 2000hrs and will be a formal dinner and awards ceremony. The evening will include live music.

Sunday Service, 15 October: A Sunday service will be held within the Arden room at 0930hrs. Standards of dress for the Conference weekend

Conference attendees are invited to dress in a jacket and tie for Conference. Serving personnel attending as RAFALOs are advised to wear No 2 working dress (with long sleeve shirt and tie). Officers on duty taking part in the ceremonial events will be wearing No 1 HD with medals. Saturday 14 October (Gala Awards Dinner): This is a Black-Tie Dinner; therefore, the recommendation for serving personnel attending as RAFALOs is No 5s for Officers, WOs and SNCOs, No 4SD (or lounge suit/black tie if preferred) for ORs. For members and guests, Black-Tie or Lounge Suit with medals (if appropriate) and ladies equivalent.

Sunday 15 October: Attendees to the ceremony are advised to wear a jacket and tie with medals (if appropriate) and the ladies equivalent. Serving personnel to wear No1 HD with medals.

#AGM2024 is going to be held at: RAF CONINGSBY on the dates of 29-02-24 to 03-03-24

The hotel is the Southview Park Hotel, Skegness, which is part of the Parkdean Holiday Resorts. (www.southviewparkhotel.co.uk)

They are able offer us a special price for early booking with prices from £130 - £250 for 2 nights based on 2 people including breakfast through to £195 - £375 for 3 nights based on 2 people including breakfast depending on the type of accommodation running from twin, double, king size, superior twin, superior double through to a suite.

There are also 3 disabled twin rooms available at £150 for 2 nights and £225 for 3 nights.

There is no discount for single bookings unfortunately but then again there isn't when one books at a Premier Inn.

Possibly the biggest problem is that the company and indeed the hotel do NOT offer a cancellation policy and that the cost of the stay must be paid at the time of booking.
